## What to do:

Decorate a copy paper box with lid or a box sized approximately 17" long, 11" wide, and 10"deep. No glitter or large decorations on top as boxes have to be stacked. See below for the grocery list of items to place in the box. Check expiration dates and make sure everything is within serving range. Purchase only "Easy Pull" top cans whenever possible. Name brands listed are examples, but not required.
