Our Meals on Wheels recipients will be so grateful to receive their very own Fall Harvest Box of much needed items. Thank you for sharing this box of blessings with our home bound senior citizens. Our Custer Road goal is to collect 150 boxes!

What to do:

Decorate a copy paper box with lid or a box sized approximately 17" long, 11" wide, and 10" deep. No glitter or large decorations on top as boxes have to be stacked. See below for the grocery list of items to place in the box. Check expiration dates and make sure everything is within serving range. Purchase only "Easy Pull" top cans whenever possible. Name brands listed are examples, but not required.

- (2) Tyson Premium Chunk White Chicken Breast in 7 oz. packet - Please no large cans without a pull top if you cannot find packets
- (2) Starkist Charlie's Lunch Kit (To Go)
- (1) 10 oz. Microwaveable Complete Meal (on grocery shelf with other non-refrigerated microwaveable food). Turkey with vegetables and chicken and noodles recommended.
- (1) Libby's 4-pack microwavable vegetables
- (1) 4-pack mixed fruit cups (in light syrup or juice)
- (2) Campbell's easy pull top Tomato Soup
- (1) package of Wheat Thins Original crackers
- (1) package containing 6-8 packs of cheese crackers
- (1) box-10 count pouches of Quaker Instant Microwavable Oatmeal
- (1) 10-18 oz. jar of peanut butter
- (1) 10 oz. jar of Simply Fruit jelly
- (2) bars of soap
- (1) pack of (4) toilet paper rolls
- (1) box 110-count Kleenex tissues
- (1) container of sanitizing wipes
